HB 1033 -- SMART METERS

SPONSOR: Unsicker

This bill requires all utility service providers to allow customers to choose between smart meters and traditional meters, and provides that such utility service providers shall not impose a disincentive on a customer for opting to use a traditional meter. Notice provisions for the installation of smart meters, requesting change of meters, and time limits for performance are specified in the bill. Data communicated by any smart metering network technology must be encrypted, and may be withheld from law enforcement except by warrant or lawful court order.

This bill is similar to HB 196 (2017).
