

HB 1081 -- CHIEF JUVENILE OFFICERS

SPONSOR: Remole

This bill requires each judicial circuit to elect a chief juvenile officer and permits each juvenile court to appoint other necessary juvenile court personnel. The chief juvenile officer must be elected at the general election every six years and must enter upon the duties of office on the first day in January next following his or her election.

This bill is the same as HB 2818 (2016).
