

HB 1136 -- EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

SPONSOR: Corlew

This bill grants Clay County the ability to use all or a part of the moneys accrued from an emergency telephone tax for central dispatching of emergency services.

This bill also provides for an alternative method for the creation of an emergency services board for those counties and municipalities that have contracted for emergency response services in response to a request from a municipality and other political subdivisions.

This bill is similar to HCS HB 334 (2017).
