

SCS SB 404 -- TRANSPORTATION OF WINE

SPONSOR: Hegeman (Alferman)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Small Business by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 12 to 0.

This bill repeals a current statute that provides that the holder of a retailer alcoholic beverage license may ship no more than two cases of wine per year to an adult resident of this state.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will fix an outdated statute prohibiting deliveries to a neighboring county.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Kelley (127) on behalf of Senator Hegeman.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
