8	(2) "Individually identifiable health information" as used in this section includes any
9	information about the treatment or prospective treatment of the patient or prospective patient,
10	including: names, birthdates, phone numbers, residential addresses, vehicle identification numbers,
11	fax numbers, device identifiers and serial numbers, email addresses, universal resource locators
12	(URLs), social security numbers, internet protocol (IP) addresses, medical record numbers,
13	biometric identifiers including finger and voice prints, full face photographic images and any
14	comparable images, and any additional information if used alone or in combination with other
15	information would identify an individual who is the subject of the information;
16	(3) Any person who knowingly releases individually identifiable health information
17	protected under this section without lawful authorization is guilty of a class A misdemeanor."; and

19	Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20	accordingly.
