2 Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "210.070. ~~[Every]~~ 1. A physician, midwife, or nurse who shall be in attendance upon a  
5 newborn infant or its mother[;] shall drop into the eyes of such infant ~~[immediately after delivery,]~~ a  
6 prophylactic [solution] medication approved by the state department of health and senior services[;  
7 ~~and shall within forty-eight hours thereafter, report in writing to the board of health or county~~  
8 ~~physician of the city, town or county where such birth occurs, his or her compliance with this~~  
9 ~~section, stating the solution used by him or her].~~

10 2. Administration of such eye drops shall not be required if a parent or legal guardian of  
11 such infant objects to the treatment because it is against the religious beliefs of the parent or legal  
12 guardian."; and

14 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
15 accordingly.
