1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 672,  
2 Page 3, Section 210.115, Line 65, by inserting immediately after said line the following:

4 "9. If any physician, resident, intern, nurse, hospital or clinic personnel, or any other health  
5 care provider who is engaged in the examination, care, treatment, or research of persons becomes  
6 aware that a birth mother or child, within eight hours after the child's birth, tested positive for a  
7 blood alcohol content of eight-hundredths of one percent or more by weight or tested positive for  
8 cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine, or a controlled substance as defined in section 195.010 or  
9 prescription drug other than a controlled substance or prescription drug for which the birth mother  
10 or child has a valid prescription and reports such diagnosis to the children's division, the division  
11 shall submit a referral to the juvenile office as soon as reasonably possible. The referral shall  
12 include the division's recommendations to the juvenile office regarding the care, safety, and  
13 placement of the child and the reasons for such recommendations."; and

15 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
16 accordingly.
