Offered By 1 AMEND Senate Joint Resolution No. 27, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by inserting immediately after 2 said line the following: 3 4 "Section 4. Each representative shall be twenty-four years of age, and next before the day of 5 his election shall have been a qualified voter for two years and a resident of the county or district which he is chosen to represent for one year, if such county or district shall have been so long 6 7 established, and if not, then of the county or district from which the same shall have been taken. No 8 person shall be eligible for the office of representative if at the expiration of the time for filing for 9 such office he or she is subject to an unpaid outstanding fine or penalty imposed by the Missouri ethics commission. 10 11 Section 6. Each senator shall be thirty years of age, and next before the day of his election 12 shall have been a qualified voter of the state for three years and a resident of the district which he is chosen to represent for one year, if such district shall have been so long established, and if not, then 13 14 of the district or districts from which the same shall have been taken. No person shall be eligible for 15 the office of senator if at the expiration of the time for filing for such office he or she is subject to an unpaid outstanding fine or penalty imposed by the Missouri ethics commission."; and 16 17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references 18 19 accordingly.
