1 AMEND House Amendment No. _____ to House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 743,
2 Page 1, Line 1, by inserting after the number "743," the following:

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4 "Page 1, Section 162.401, Line 9, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

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6 "162.621. 1. The board of education shall have general and supervising control,
7 government and management of the public schools and public school property of the district in the
8 city and shall exercise generally all powers in the administration of the public school system therein.
9 The board of education has all the powers of other school districts under the laws of this state except
10 as herein provided and shall perform all duties required by general laws of school districts so far as
11 they are applicable to the public school affairs of the city and are consistent with this law. It shall
12 appoint the officers, agents and employees it deems necessary and proper and fix their
13 compensation. The board of education may:

14 (1) Make, amend and repeal rules and bylaws for its meetings and proceedings, for the
15 government, regulation and management of the public schools and school property in the city, for
16 the transaction of its business, and the examination, qualification and employment of teachers,
17 which rules and bylaws are binding on the board of education and all parties dealing with it until
18 formally repealed;

19 (2) Fix the time of its meetings;

20 (3) Provide for special and standing committees;

21 (4) Levy taxes authorized by law for school purposes;

22 (5) Invest the funds of the district;

23 (6) Purchase and hold all property, real and personal, deemed by it necessary for the
24 purposes of public education;

25 (7) Build and construct improvements for such purposes, and sell the same;

26 (8) Provide for the gratuitous transportation of pupils to and from schools in cases where by
27 reason of special circumstances pupils are required to attend schools at unusual distances from their
28 residences;

29 (9) Contract with nonprofit corporations to provide for the operation of schools; and

30 (10) Establish school site councils to facilitate site-based school management and to

31 improve the needs of the local geographic attendance region of the school.

32 2. A superintendent of the district in the city shall not be terminated unless a minimum of
33 two-thirds of the governing body of the district vote to terminate the superintendent.

1 3. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the powers granted in subsection 1 of this
2 section shall be vested, in the manner provided in section 162.1100, in the special administrative
3 board of the transitional school district containing the city not within a county if the school district
4 loses its accreditation from the state board of education. Thereafter, such powers shall immediately
5 revert to the board of directors of the school district for any period of time for which no transitional
6 school district containing the city not within a county is in existence. The board of directors of the
7 school district shall, at all times, retain auditing and public reporting powers."; and

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9 Further amend said bill,"; and

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11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
12 accordingly.
