1 AMEND House Bill No. 1590, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said line the  
2 following:

4 "537.046. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "Childhood sexual abuse", any act committed by the defendant against the plaintiff  
6 which act occurred when the plaintiff was under the age of eighteen years and which act would have  
7 been a violation of section 566.030, 566.031, 566.040 as it existed prior to August 28, 2013,  
8 566.050, 566.060, 566.061, 566.070 as it existed prior to August 28, 2013, 566.080, 566.090 as it  
9 existed prior to August 28, 2013, 566.100, 566.101, 566.110, [or] 566.120, or [section] 568.020;

10 (2) "Injury" or "illness", either a physical injury or illness or a psychological injury or  
11 illness. A psychological injury or illness need not be accompanied by physical injury or illness.

12 2. Any action to recover damages from injury or illness caused by childhood sexual abuse  
13 that occurred prior to August 28, 2018, in an action brought pursuant to this section shall be  
14 commenced within ten years of the plaintiff attaining the age of twenty-one or within three years of  
15 the date the plaintiff discovers, or reasonably should have discovered, that the injury or illness was  
16 caused by childhood sexual abuse, whichever later occurs. Any action to recover damages from  
17 injury or illness caused by childhood sexual abuse that occurred on or after August 28, 2018, in an  
18 action brought under this section shall be commenced within twenty years of the plaintiff attaining  
19 the age of eighteen or within three years of the date the plaintiff discovers, or reasonably should  
20 have discovered, that the injury or illness was caused by childhood sexual abuse, whichever later  
21 occurs.

22 [~~3. This section shall apply to any action commenced on or after August 28, 2004, including~~  
23 ~~any action which would have been barred by the application of the statute of limitation applicable~~  
24 ~~prior to that date.]"; and~~
