1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1248, Page 3, Section 311.188, Line 3, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "311.300. 1. Except as provided in ~~[subsections 2, 3 and 4 of]~~ this section, no person under
5 the age of twenty-one years shall sell or assist in the sale or dispensing of intoxicating liquor.

6 2. In any place of business licensed in accordance with section 311.200, persons at least
7 eighteen years of age may stock, arrange displays, operate the cash register or scanner connected to
8 a cash register and accept payment for, and sack for carryout, intoxicating liquor. Delivery of
9 intoxicating liquor away from the licensed business premises cannot be performed by anyone under
10 the age of twenty-one years. Any licensee who employs any person under the age of twenty-one
11 years, as authorized by this subsection, shall, when at least fifty percent of the licensee's gross sales
12 does not consist of nonalcoholic sales, have an employee twenty-one years of age or older on the
13 licensed premises during all hours of operation.

14 3. In any distillery, warehouse, wholesale distributorship, or similar place of business which
15 stores or distributes intoxicating liquor but which does not sell intoxicating liquor at retail, persons
16 at least eighteen years of age may be employed and their duties may include the handling of
17 intoxicating liquor for all purposes except consumption, sale at retail, or dispensing for consumption
18 or sale at retail.

19 4. Any wholesaler licensed pursuant to this chapter may employ persons of at least eighteen
20 years of age to:

21 (1) Rotate, stock and arrange displays at retail establishments licensed to sell intoxicating
22 liquor; and

23 (2) Unload delivery vehicles and transfer intoxicating liquor into retail licensed premises if
24 such persons are supervised by the delivery vehicle drivers who are twenty-one years of age or
25 older.

26 [4.] 5. Persons eighteen years of age or older may, when acting in the capacity of a waiter
27 or waitress, accept payment for or serve intoxicating liquor in places of business which sell food for
28 consumption on the premises if at least fifty percent of all sales in those places consists of food;
29 provided that nothing in this section shall authorize persons under twenty-one years of age to mix or
30 serve across the bar intoxicating beverages."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
33 accordingly.
