1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 727, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by  
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "386.822. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "Advanced meter", a meter or metering device system that is owned or leased by a  
6 utility or its agent and that meets one or more of the following requirements:

7 (a) Measures, records, or sends a customer's utility usage or other data by use of radio  
8 waves or broadband over power lines;

9 (b) Allows for two-way communication between the meter and the utility or its agent; or

10 (c) Allows for a utility or its agent to control a customer's thermostat, appliance, or service;

11 (2) "Traditional meter", an analog or similar meter that is unable to transmit usage  
12 information and is only intended to be read by an individual through a visual display. A traditional  
13 meter is not designed to be and is not capable of transmitting usage data by using radio waves or  
14 broadband over power lines, allowing two-way communication between the meter and the utility or  
15 its agents, or allowing a utility or its agents to control a customer's thermostat, appliance, or service.  
16 A traditional meter does not include an advanced meter that has certain functionality turned off or  
17 deactivated;

18 (3) "Utility", any entity regulated by the commission under chapter 386 or 393.

19 2. A utility shall not install an advanced meter, upgrade the functionality of a previously  
20 installed advanced meter, or replace a customer's meter with an advanced meter, a traditional meter,  
21 or any other type of meter unless:

22 (1) Prior to such installation, upgrade, or replacement, the utility attempts to notify the  
23 customer of the intended installation, upgrade, or replacement. Such attempt may be made by mail,  
24 electronic means, telephone, or door hanger, and shall be separate from any billing mailing or  
25 notification;

26 (2) Immediately before performing the installation, upgrade, or replacement, the on-site  
27 utility worker or his or her agent attempts to orally inform the customer of the installation, upgrade,  
28 or replacement; and

29 (3) After performing the installation, upgrade, or replacement, the on-site utility worker shall leave  
30 written notice of work performed."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
33 accordingly.
