12 13	 (1) Sexual harassment, assault, rape, or other alleged crimes; (2) Discrimination on the basis of religion or religious belief or practice, age,
14 15	<u>disability, race, gender, national origin, or familial status; or</u> (3) Violations of section 197.032 prohibiting an employer from forcing employees to
16 17	participate in an abortion.
18 19 20	Any agreement, understanding, or practice, written or oral, implied or expressed, between any employer and an employee that violates the rights of employees as guaranteed under this section is declared to be unlawful, null and void, and of no legal effect. Any person who directly or indirectly
21 22	violates any provision of this section shall be guilty of a class C misdemeanor. Any person injured as a result of any violation or threatened violation of this section may recover any and all damages
23 24 25	of any character resulting from such violation or threatened violation including costs and reasonable attorney's fees. Such remedies shall be independent of and in addition to the other penalties and remedies proscribed under this section."; and
