2 Senate Bill No. 826, Page 13, Section 195.265, Line 18, by inserting after all of said section and
3 line the following:

5 "210.070. ~~[Every]~~ 1. A physician, midwife, or nurse who shall be in attendance upon a
6 newborn infant or its mother[;] shall drop into the eyes of such infant ~~[immediately after delivery,]~~ a
7 prophylactic [solution] medication approved by the state department of health and senior services[;
8 and shall within forty-eight hours thereafter, report in writing to the board of health or county
9 physician of the city, town or county where such birth occurs, his or her compliance with this
10 section, stating the solution used by him or her].

11 2. Administration of such eye drops shall not be required if a parent or legal guardian of
12 such infant objects to the treatment because it is against the religious beliefs of the parent or legal
13 guardian."; and

15 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
16 accordingly.
