1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 598,
2 Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting immediately after said section and line the following:

4 "227.100. 1. All contracts for the construction of said work shall be let to the lowest
5 responsible bidder or bidders after notice and publication of an advertisement in a newspaper
6 published in the county where the work is to be done, and in such other publications as the
7 commission may determine. In determining the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, the
8 department of transportation shall consider the complete life-cycle cost of the work, including but
9 not limited to factors such as initial cost and all anticipated costs for subsequent maintenance, repair,
10 or resurfacing over the life of the work. The department of transportation shall develop and
11 implement a life-cycle cost analysis for any project for which the estimated total pavement costs
12 exceed one million dollars funded in whole or in part with state funds. The department of
13 transportation shall design each such project in both hot mix asphalt and portland cement concrete
14 pavement, and shall award paving projects utilizing the material having the lowest life-cycle cost.
15 The design of hot mix asphalt and portland cement concrete pavement methods and life-cycle cost
16 analysis shall be conducted in accordance with the department of transportation's currently
17 established practices and policies.

18 2. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or a cashier's check or a bid bond,
19 guaranteed by a surety company authorized by the director of the department of insurance, financial
20 institutions and professional registration to conduct surety business in the state of Missouri, equal to
21 five percent of the bid, which certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond shall be deposited with
22 the commissioner as a guaranty and forfeited to the state treasurer to the credit of the state road fund
23 in the event the successful bidder fails to comply with the terms of the proposal, and return to the
24 successful bidder on execution and delivery of the performance bond provided for in subsection 4.
25 The checks of the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them in accordance with the terms of the
26 proposal.

27 3. All notices of the letting of contracts under this section shall state the time and place
28 when and where bids will be received and opened, and all bids shall be sealed and opened only at
29 the time and place mentioned in such notice and in the presence of some member of the commission
30 or some person named by the commission for such purpose.

31 4. The successful bidders for the construction of said work shall enter into contracts
32 furnished and prescribed by the commission and shall give good and sufficient bond, in a sum equal
33 to the contract price, to the state of Missouri, with sureties approved by the commission and to
34 ensure the proper and prompt completion of said work in accordance with the provisions of said
35 contracts, and plans and specifications; provided, that if, in the opinion of the majority of the
36 members of the commission, the lowest bid or bids for the construction of any of the roads, or parts

1 of roads, herein authorized to be constructed, shall be excessive, then, and in that event, said
2 commission shall have the right, and it is hereby empowered and authorized to reject any or all bids,
3 and to construct, under its own direction and supervision, all of such roads and bridges, or any part
4 thereof."; and

6 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
7 accordingly.
