1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 850, Page 13, Section 210.150, Line 142,  
2 by inserting after the words "to be heard." the following:

3  
4 "In the event that the department determines that the receiving agency is not subject to such a  
5 prohibition by law, the department may enter into a memorandum of understanding with the  
6 receiving agency that shall contain such a prohibition. The memorandum of understanding shall  
7 provide that:

8 (1) A copy of the memorandum of understanding shall be placed with each document  
9 shared with the receiving agency;

10 (2) The memorandum of understanding's terms are binding individually on the employees  
11 of the receiving agency and its contractors; and

12 (3) The child or children mentioned in the shared documents, the members of their  
13 immediate families, and all persons mentioned in the shared documents with a connection to  
14 unsubstantiated claims of abuse and neglect are third-party beneficiaries under the memorandum of  
15 understanding."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
18 accordingly.
