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7	"37.675. 1. There is hereby established in the office of administration the "Missouri Office
8	of Equal Opportunity". All authority, powers, and privileges of the state office of equal
9	employment opportunity, which was established by executive order, shall be transferred to the
10	Missouri office of equal opportunity.
11	2. The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall have the mission to ensure that all present
12	and prospective employees are afforded equal opportunity at all levels and phases of employment
13	within state government with respect to, but not limited to, hiring, recruiting, training, benefits,
14	promotions, transfers, layoffs, demotions, terminations, rate of compensation, and recalls from
15	layoffs. It shall also work to ensure that the state does not discriminate against any person on
16	account of age, ancestry, color, disability, national origin, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or
17	veteran status.
18	3. (1) The governor shall, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, appoint an
19	officer to head the Missouri office of equal opportunity.
20	(2) Subject to appropriations, the commissioner of administration shall provide the officer
21	with such facilities, staff, resources, equipment, and supplies as are necessary to carry out the duties
22	set forth herein. The officer shall submit a proposal each fiscal year to the commissioner of
23	administration detailing the needs of the Missouri office of equal opportunity.
24	(3) The officer shall be the state's chief compliance officer to ensure that the state is
25	complying with all federal and state laws concerning equal employment opportunity and workforce
26	diversity.
27	4. The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall have the following duties and
28	responsibilities:
29	(1) The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall have primary responsibility for assisting
30	in the coordination and implementation of workforce diversity programs throughout all departments
31	and offices of the state government;
32	(2) The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall advise the governor on issues regarding
33	equal employment opportunity, workforce diversity, and efforts to administer workforce diversity

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1	action goals and timetables for implementation throughout the departments and offices of the state
2	government;
3	(3) The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall review progress reports of state
4	departments and offices and shall meet biannually with each department director to evaluate
5	departmental results and determine the course of future workforce diversity goals, timetables,
6	recruiting, planning, and implementation. The results of each meeting shall be reported in writing
7	to the commissioner of administration;
8	(4) By January first of each year, the Missouri office of equal opportunity shall provide a
9	report to the commissioner of administration, general assembly, and governor that summarizes the
10	activities of each department and that contains recommendations for additional programs to
11	accomplish the mission of the Missouri office of equal opportunity; and
12	(5) The Missouri office of equal opportunity shall monitor all departments and offices of the
13	state government and assist them to ensure equal employment opportunity.
14	5. Each state department shall submit a revised workforce diversity plan to the Missouri
15	office of equal opportunity by September thirtieth of each year. The primary responsibility for
16	developing the workforce diversity plan shall rest with each department director. The Missouri
17	office of equal opportunity shall review and approve each submitted plan."; and"; and
