1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 819, Page 7, Section 210.487, Line 59, by inserting immediately after said  
2 section and line the following:

4 "571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful possession of a firearm if such  
5 person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:

6 (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state, or of a crime  
7 under the laws of any state or of the United States which, if committed within this state, would be a  
8 felony, or has been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence; [or]

9 (2) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated or drugged  
10 condition, [or] is currently adjudged mentally incompetent, is illegally or unlawfully in the United  
11 States, has been discharged from the Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions, or, having been a  
12 citizen of the United States, has renounced United States citizenship; or

13 (3) Such person is subject to a court order that:

14 (a) Was issued after a hearing of which such person received actual notice, and at which  
15 such person had an opportunity to participate;

16 (b) Restrains such person from harassing, stalking, or threatening a petitioner, as defined in  
17 subdivision (11) of section 455.010, or a child of such petitioner, or engaging in other conduct that  
18 would place such petitioner in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the petitioner or child; and:

19 a. Includes a finding that such person represents a credible threat to the physical safety of  
20 such petitioner or child; or

21 b. By its terms explicitly prohibits the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical  
22 force against such petitioner or child that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury.

23 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class D felony.

24 3. The provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section shall not apply to the  
25 possession of an antique firearm.

26 Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to protect Missouri citizens from the  
27 dangers inherent in violent individuals having access to firearms, section 571.070 of this act is  
28 deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety,  
29 and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section  
30 571.070 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
33 accordingly.
