1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 870, Page 43,  
2 Section 221.520, Line 46, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "320.086. 1. Nothing contained in sections 320.081 to 320.086 shall allow access to records  
5 otherwise closed under sections 610.100 to 610.105[, RSMo Supp. 1982].

6 2. Nothing contained in sections 320.081 to 320.086 shall restrict or waive the attorney-  
7 client privilege.

8 3. The portion of a record that is individually identifiable health information as defined by  
9 the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), P.L. 104-191, as  
10 amended, may be closed records as provided under sections 610.100 to 610.105 if maintained by  
11 fire departments and fire protection districts. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all fire departments  
12 and fire protection districts shall produce for every call to the department or district an "incident  
13 report" as defined in section 610.100 that shall include the date, time, specific location, and name of  
14 the owner of the specific location or any vehicle involved in the incident, if known. All incident  
15 reports shall be open records under section 620.100."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
18 accordingly.
