	6. (1) There is hereby established a standing subcommittee of the State Advisory Council
	on Emergency Medical Services (SAC) to monitor the implementation of the recognition of the
	EMS personnel licensure interstate compact (REPLICA), the interstate commission for EMS
	personnel practice, and the involvement of the state of Missouri. The subcommittee of SAC shall
	meet at least biannually and receive reports from the Missouri delegate to the interstate commissi
	for EMS personnel practice. The subcommittee shall consist of at least seven members appointed
	by the chair of SAC, to include at least two members as recommended by the Missouri State
	Council of Firefighters and one member as recommended by the Missouri Association of Fire
