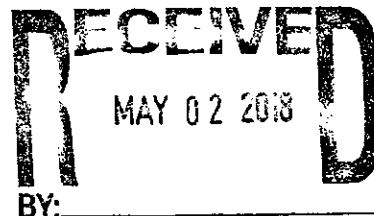

SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1Offered by Munzlinger of LewisAmend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 2034, Page 10, Section 195.010, Line 8

2 of said page, by inserting immediately after said line the
3 following:

4 "(20) "Illegal industrial hemp":

5 (a) All nonseed parts and varieties of the Cannabis sativa
6 L. plant, growing or not, that contain an average delta-9
7 tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) concentration exceeding three-tenths
8 of one percent on a dry weight basis;

9 (b) "Illegal industrial hemp" shall be destroyed in the
10 most effective manner possible, and such destruction shall be
11 verified by the Missouri state highway patrol;"; and

12 Further amend said bill and section, page 11, lines 22-28 of
13 said page, by striking all of said lines; and

14 Further amend said bill and section, page 12, line 1 of said
15 page, by striking all of said line; and further amend said
16 section by renumbering the subdivisions accordingly; and

17 Further amend said bill and section, page 12, line 3 of said
18 page, by inserting at the end of said line the following: "L.";
19 and

20 Further amend said bill, page 57, section 195.764, line 6 of
21 said page, by striking "195.746" and inserting in lieu thereof
22 the following: "195.740".
