1 AMEND House Amendment No. _____ to House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate
2 Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 966, Page 2, Line 24, by inserting after all of said line the
3 following:

5 "Further amend said bill, Page 36, Section 566.147, Line 42, by inserting after all of said line the following:
6 "567.050. 1. A person commits the offense of promoting prostitution in the first degree if he or she
7 knowingly:

8 (1) Promotes prostitution by compelling a person to enter into, engage in, or remain in prostitution;
9 [or]

10 (2) Promotes prostitution of a person less than sixteen years of age; or
11 (3) Owns, manages, or operates an interactive computer service, as defined 47 U.S.C. Section
12 230(f), or conspires or attempts to do so, with the intent to promote or facilitate the prostitution of another.

13 2. The term "compelling" includes:

14 (1) The use of forcible compulsion;

15 (2) The use of a drug or intoxicating substance to render a person incapable of controlling his
16 conduct or appreciating its nature;

17 (3) Withholding or threatening to withhold dangerous drugs or a narcotic from a drug dependent
18 person.

19 3. The offense of promoting prostitution in the first degree is a class B felony, or a class A felony if
20 a person violates subdivision (3) of subsection 1 of this section and acts in reckless disregard of the fact that
21 such conduct contributed to the offense of trafficking for the purposes of sexual exploitation under section
22 566.209.

23 4. A person injured by the acts committed in violation subdivision (3) of subsection 1 of this section
24 and subdivisions (1) and (2) of subsection 3 of this section shall have a civil cause of action to recover
25 damages and reasonable attorneys' fees for such injury.

26 5. In addition to the court's authority to order a defendant to make restitution for the damage or loss
27 caused by his or her offense as provided in section 559.105, the court shall enter a judgment of restitution
28 against the offender convicted of violating subdivision (3) of subsection 1 of this section and subdivision (2)
29 of subsection 3 of this section."; and"; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
