The MO HealthNet oversight committee shall conduct research and investigate any potential health-related savings and revenues associated with expanding eligibility to persons under subsection 1 of this section. The committee shall investigate the federal matching rate below which the state could not maintain the expanded eligibility to persons under subsection 1 of this section. If the amount is determined to be greater than ninety percent, the committee shall report its findings to the general assembly for its consideration prior to any vote under paragraph (b) of subdivision (1) of subsection 4 of this section. In conducting its research and investigation, the committee shall also determine the feasibility of:
- (1) Implementing capped cost-sharing for persons eligible under subsection 1 of this section, which may be reduced based on healthy behaviors of participants;

- (2) Expanding Medicaid coverage for certain health care services that are currently financed by the state; and
- (3) Enrolling persons under subsection 1 of this section in private health benefit plans. Section B.
