ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Attorney General's Office**, the **Office of Prosecution Services**, and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Branson Police Department** state this bill is unlikely to cost our city anything extra as we already have a city attorney that can complete the motion. Additionally, this bill has the potential to save the city money by allowing us to more quickly dispose of property and thus eliminating the storage costs.

Officials from the Cass County Sheriff's Department, the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, the Columbia Police Department, the Independence Police Department, the Jasper County Sheriff's Department, the Platte County Sheriff's Department, the St. Charles Police Department, and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
