House Amendment #1:

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Corrections**, the **Department of Public Safety, Missouri State Highway Patrol** and the **Office of State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal, as amended, would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
