FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of Administration Division of Budget and Planning (B&P)** assume this would not impact B&P and will not have a direct impact on General and Total State Revenue.

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development** (**DED**) assume there is a chance that the legislation could impact some DED programs and potentially cause the state to approve a program that it otherwise would not approve. There is no way to calculate an impact.

Officials at the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Conservation, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Revenue, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Department of Social Services, the Columbia/Boone County Department of Health and Human Services, and the Harrison County Health Department each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to the previous version, the **Department of Higher Education**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Public Safety**, **St. Louis County**, and the **Summersville R-II School District** each assumed there was no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes this proposal requires that all development applications (as defined in the bill) be approved or denied by the state agencies within six months. If no action is taken in the six months the application is considered approved. Oversight assumes the agencies will be able to adjust any approval process to meet the requirements of this proposal.
