# ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Personnel** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** and the **Department of Public Safety** - **Missouri Veterans Commission** each defer to the Office of Administration to estimate the fiscal impact of the proposed legislation on their respective organization.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning (B&P)** assume this proposal has no impact on the TSR or the 18(3) calculation. B&P defers to OA for any other impacts.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office (AGO)** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources. AGO may seek additional appropriations if the proposal results in a significant increase in cases.

Officials from the **Office of the State Auditor** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume there may be some fiscal impact but there no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget request.

Officials from the **Office of the Lieutenant Governor** assume this proposal would cost two extra hours of salary depending on the employee.
