ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

§301.010

Adds definition for "recreational trailer".

§301.067

Allows registration fees for "recreational trailers' to be payable in May of each year beginning August 28, 2018. Any fee that would have been due in December 2018 shall be deferred until May 2019. A "recreational trailer" means a trailer used for the purpose of providing temporary housing quarters.

Administrative Impact

To implement the proposed changes, the Department will be required to:

- Update procedures and the Department website;
- Update correspondence letters; and
- Complete programming and user acceptance testing for identified systems.

OA-ITSD services will be required at a cost of \$15,471 (206.28 hours x \$75 per hour) in FY 2019.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb some of the costs related to this proposal; therefore, Oversight will reflect a fiscal impact of \$15,471 for IT services in FY 2019.

This bill changes the annual registration fee for recreational trailers from December 2018 to May 2019 and defers any fee due in December, 2018 to May, 2019.
