FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** state, currently, music therapy is not a covered service under First Steps. The addition of this service as a covered service via this legislation would increase the costs of the program. To determine the fiscal impact, DESE averaged three of our current services that are infrequently utilized (counseling, vision and audiology) for an estimated 2,500 hours/year for music therapy services. And assuming the rate will be the same as other therapies (\$68/hr.), DESE estimated a fiscal impact of \$170,000/year.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.
