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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** assume this proposal would expand a 2014 bill (HCS SB 600) to include not just active military but all veterans.

SOS states that by waiving fees under sections:

- Regarding the organization of limited liability companies and name reservations in Chapter 347.
- Regarding the organization of corporations in Chapter 351.
- Regarding the organization of not-for-profit corporations in Chapter 355
- Regarding the organization of cooperative associations in Chapter 357
- Regarding the organization of limited liability partnerships in Chapter 358,
- Regarding the organization of limited partnerships in Chapter 359,
- Regarding the organization of rural electric cooperatives in Chapter 394, and
- Regarding the registration and renewal of fictitious names in Chapter 417.
- Total State Revenue would be affected.

5% of businesses in Missouri are veteran-owned. It is assumed that not all veterans eligible for this program will utilize it so the veteran participation rate is set at 3%.

The Business Services Division began by observing projections for the total number of expected filings for FY 2019 through FY 2021 for each of the types of filing affected by this proposal. Those projections were then adjusted to reflect the 5% of businesses owned by veterans and the expected rate of 60% at which veterans would take advantage of the business creation incentives provided by this proposal, for a total of 3% of affected filings.

This proposal would expand the current program known as "Startup for Soldiers." There are 480,000 veterans in Missouri according to United States Census data from https://www2.census.gov/library/visualizations/2015/comm/vets/mo-vets.pdf, and 49,000 veteran owned businesses.

Missouri has around 900,000 business entities registered with SOS. Percentage of those owned by veteran is 5%

2014 Truly Agreed To and Finally Passed HCS for SB 600 bill has resulted in the below refunds or fees waived. In 2014 it was assumed 51,000 available to participate.

SOS also assumes the office would have to conduct a business analysis in order to change the automated processes performed by our business software. The IT department would need to create new tables, reports, and software application process to allow "Benefit Corporations" to be a filing type for creation and amending, change the wording on certain screens through the online application, and update the current merge form. SOS anticipates a one-time cost of \$70,000 to change the current software operated by the Business Services Division.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety-Veterans** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small business started by veterans would have fewer startup costs because the fees for business creation would be waived.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposal waives certain business fees when a specified organizer, majority shareholder, officer, director, or partner of a company, corporation, health services corporation, nonprofit corporation, cooperative company, or partnership is a veteran, resides in Missouri, and provides proof of military service to the Secretary of State.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
