FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement (JCPER)** assume this legislation would permit additional entities to join LAGERS (Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System). Any entity eligible to join LAGERS under this legislation would likely need to follow other statutory and regulatory requirements. Our review of this legislation would indicate that its provisions do not create a "substantial proposed change" in future plan benefits as defined in section 105.660(10). Therefore, an actuarial cost statement is not required.
