# **ASSUMPTION**

**Oversight** assumes this proposal would allow a child who is homeless or in the custody of the Department of Social Service's Children's Division to enroll in a daycare center, nursery or preschool if they cannot provide evidence of required immunizations. This proposal requires evidence that the child has all appropriate immunizations or has begun the process of immunization to be presented within 30 days of enrollment.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** and **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.
