# ASSUMPTION

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Springfield Police Department** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, the Branson Police Department, the Clay County Sheriff's Department, the Columbia Police Department, the Greene County Sheriff's Department, the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department, the Platte County Sheriff's Department, and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
