## AN ACT

To amend chapter 302, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to driver's licenses.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 302, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 302.205, to read as follows:

302.205. 1. Any resident of this state may elect to have a medical alert notation  
2 placed on the person's driver's license to alert emergency medical responders that the  
3 person is carrying a separate emergency medical card.

4 2. The director of the department of revenue may promulgate all necessary rules  
5 and regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that  
6 term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this  
7 section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions  
8 of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are  
9 nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to  
10 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are  
11 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule  
12 proposed or adopted after August 28, 2018, shall be invalid and void.
