### AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to department of conservation resident landowner privileges.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 252.280, to read as follows:

**252.280. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any United States**  
2 **citizen who is not a resident of Missouri but owns at least seventy-five acres of property in**  
3 **Missouri may receive the same hunting, fishing, and trapping privileges as a resident**  
4 **landowner.**
