AN ACT

To amend chapter 261, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to veterinary feed directive rules.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 261, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 261.150, to read as follows:

2 **261.150. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the state or**
3 **any of its departments, agencies, political subdivisions, or entities shall not implement or**
4 **otherwise enforce 21 CFR 514 or 558, or any substantially similar federal rule, that**
5 **requires a livestock producer to obtain a veterinary feed directive in order to use**
6 **medicated feed for such livestock and requires veterinary oversight for its use. The**
7 **department of agriculture shall not adopt such federal rule or any similar rule without the**
8 **approval of the general assembly.**
