AN ACT

To repeal section 163.172, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to teacher salaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 163.172, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 163.172, to read as follows:

163.172. 1. In school year 1994-95 and thereafter until school year 2006-07, the minimum teacher's salary shall be eighteen thousand dollars. Beginning in school year 2006-07, 2 3 the minimum teacher's salary shall be twenty-two thousand dollars; in school year 2007-08, the minimum teacher's salary shall be twenty-three thousand dollars; in school year 2008-09, the 4 minimum teacher's salary shall be twenty-four thousand dollars; in school year 2009-10 and 5 thereafter through school year 2018-19, the minimum teacher's salary shall be twenty-five 6 thousand dollars; and in school year 2019-20 and thereafter, the minimum teacher's salary 7 8 shall be thirty thousand dollars, subject to appropriation. Beginning in the school year 9 1996-97 until school year 2006-07, for any full-time teacher with a master's degree and at least 10 ten years' teaching experience in a public school or combination of public schools, the minimum salary shall be twenty-four thousand dollars. Beginning in the school year 2006-07, for any 11 12 full-time teacher with a master's degree in an academic teaching field directly related to the teacher's assignment and at least ten years' teaching experience in a public school or 13 combination of public schools, the minimum salary shall be thirty thousand dollars; in the 14 2007-08 school year such minimum salary shall be thirty-one thousand dollars; in the 2008-09 15 school year such minimum salary shall be thirty-two thousand dollars; [and] in [the] school year 16 17 2009-10 [school year] and thereafter through school year 2018-19 such minimum salary shall

18 be thirty-three thousand dollars; and in school year 2019-20 and thereafter such minimum

19 salary shall be thirty-five thousand dollars, subject to appropriation.

20 2. [Beginning with the budget requests for fiscal year 1991,] There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Teacher Minimum Salary Fund". The moneys appropriated to 21 22 the fund shall be distributed to each school district on the basis of the difference between 23 the minimum salary required under subsection 1 of this section and the salary reported by 24 the district on core data for each teacher who does not make the minimum salary. If the 25 appropriation is insufficient to meet the need, the department of elementary and secondary 26 education shall prorate the appropriated amount so that the shortfall is equally distributed 27 among all eligible teachers. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In 28 accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve 29 disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the 30 fund shall be used solely for the administration of this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end 31 32 of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state 33 treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. 34 Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

35 **3.** The commissioner of education shall present to the appropriate committees of the 36 general assembly information on the average Missouri teacher's salary, regional average salary 37 data, and national average salary data.

[3.] 4. All school salary information shall be public information.

[4.] 5. As used in this section, the term "salary" shall be defined as the salary figure
which appears on the teacher's contract and as determined by the local school district's basic
salary schedule and does not include supplements for extra duties.

42 [5.] 6. The minimum salary for any fully certificated teacher employed on a less than 43 full-time basis by a school district, state school for the severely handicapped, the Missouri 44 School for the Deaf, or the Missouri School for the Blind shall be prorated to reflect the amounts 45 provided in subsection 1 of this section.
