### AN ACT

To repeal section 149.192, RSMo, relating to the taxation of tobacco.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 149.192, RSMo, is repealed as follows:

2       ~~[149.192. The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire~~  
3       ~~field of legislation increasing the taxation of cigarettes and tobacco products to~~  
4       ~~the complete exclusion of any order, ordinance or regulation by any political~~  
5       ~~subdivision of this state. Any future orders, ordinances or regulations in this field~~  
6       ~~shall be null and void. No county, city, town, village, municipality, or other~~  
7       ~~political subdivision of this state shall adopt any order, ordinance or regulation~~  
8       ~~increasing the tax levied on cigarettes and tobacco products. The tax levied by~~  
9       ~~any county, city, town, village, municipality, or other political subdivision of this~~  
      ~~state shall not exceed the amount of tax levied on September 30, 1993.]~~
