AN ACT

To repeal section 149.192, RSMo, relating to the taxation of tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 149.192, RSMo, is repealed as follows:

[149.192. The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire 2 field of legislation increasing the taxation of cigarettes and tobacco products to 3 the complete exclusion of any order, ordinance or regulation by any political 4 subdivision of this state. Any future orders, ordinances or regulations in this field 5 shall be null and void. No county, city, town, village, municipality, or other 6 political subdivision of this state shall adopt any order, ordinance or regulation 7 increasing the tax levied on cigarettes and tobacco products. The tax levied by 8 any county, city, town, village, municipality, or other political subdivision of this 9 state shall not exceed the amount of tax levied on September 30, 1993.]
