

# House Concurrent Resolution No. 63

## 99TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

2           **WHEREAS**, it is important for children of all ages to develop conscious social and  
3 historical awareness through practical leadership training, hands-on learning, and modern,  
4 dynamic extracurricular activities and education; and

5

6           **WHEREAS**, the importance of developing real-world experience and community values  
7 at an early age is magnified in light of the increasing number of high school and college  
8 graduates unable to compete in the modern workforce or find their place as ethical and valuable  
9 contributing citizens; and

10

11           **WHEREAS**, the future of our communities, state, and nation, and preservation of the  
12 sacred values, human rights, and timeless principles upon which equality, justice, and freedom  
13 stand, is dependent on giving every child the opportunity and inspiration to succeed in life; and

14

15           **WHEREAS**, in order to perpetuate human progress, enfranchise human thought,  
16 preserve the freedom of human conscience, and guarantee equal rights to all, it is crucial to focus  
17 attention on ensuring that children engage in opportunity-creating activities, leadership, and  
18 public speaking training and education, and early community involvement with adult mentors;

21           **WHEREAS**, increasing the development of essential skills and relevant, necessary  
22 education that is applicable to real-life situations will lead to a more enlightened, inspired, and  
23 optimistic citizenry; and

25           **WHEREAS**, increasing the number of young persons who designate a portion of their  
26 time each week to work and connect with adult mentors and volunteers will lead to decreased  
27 numbers of uneducated, unemployed, and uninspired citizens; and

29           **WHEREAS**, the Order of DeMolay was founded in Kansas City, Missouri in 1919 for  
30 the purpose of giving young people higher education, guidance in life, and an environment to

31 develop critical leadership skills, social value, universal moral ethics, greater intellectual  
32 learning, and the inspiration to succeed in all facets of their lives through service to others and  
33 service to our world at large; and

35 **WHEREAS**, Missouri DeMolay offers advanced degrees to its members and students,  
36 including higher education in the areas of communication, history, philosophy, psychology, and  
37 ethics and offers leadership and business training with concentrations on small and large group  
38 facilitation, project organization, public speaking, scheduling, and budgeting; and

40 **WHEREAS**, the Order of DeMolay has been a breeding ground for not only many  
41 prominent industry, business, professional sports, military, and world leaders, including  
42 presidents, governors, congressmen, astronauts, national radio and television personalities, but  
43 also a vast number of other valuable contributing citizens participating in all walks of life in our  
44 society for nearly a century; and

46 **WHEREAS**, graduates of the DeMolay program, including Governor Melvin E.  
47 Carnahan; entertainers and entrepreneurs Walt Disney, Mel Blanc, Burl Ives, Paul Harvey,  
48 Buddy Ebsen, John Wayne, and Gary Collins; author John Steinbeck, astronauts Frank Borman  
49 and Edgar Mitchell; journalist Paul Harvey; Governor and U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Edward  
50 T. Schafer; Ambassador Leonard G. Shurtleff; professional football player Fran Tarkenton;  
51 Congressman and Ambassador Walter C. Ploeser; president and CEO of the San Diego Chargers  
52 Dean Spanos; Senator and Governor Mark Hatfield; Olympian and politician Bob Mathias; and  
53 broadcasting legends Walter Cronkite, Dan Rather, David C. Goodnow, and John King, to name  
54 a few, have all profusely expressed that their early experiences and higher education in the Order  
55 of DeMolay were the foundation and springboard to their successes; and

57 **WHEREAS**, President Harry S. Truman of Missouri was elected as an Honorary Grand  
58 Master of the International Supreme Council of the Order of DeMolay, and he frequently sought  
59 the counsel and wisdom of DeMolay's founder, Frank S. Land. President Truman publically and  
60 fervently revered the youth leadership organization and exclaimed, "The greatest honor that has  
61 ever come to me, and that can ever come to me in my life, is to be the Grand Master of Masons  
62 in Missouri," the sponsoring body of Missouri DeMolay; and

64 **WHEREAS**, Walt Disney, an original member of the DeMolay Chapter in Kansas City,  
65 Mother Chapter, and founder of what is now a worldwide and massively iconic company, stated,  
66 "I feel a great sense of obligation and gratitude toward the Order of DeMolay for the important  
67 part it played in my life. Its precepts have been invaluable in making decisions, facing dilemmas,

68 and crises. DeMolay stands for all that is good for the family and for our country. I feel  
69 privileged to have enjoyed membership in DeMolay”; and

70

71 **WHEREAS**, the Order of DeMolay is a youth leadership organization built on  
72 wholesome, fundamental values that transcend religious, political, or ideological affiliation: love  
73 of parents, reverence for all that is sacred, courtesy, friendship, fidelity, cleanness, and  
74 patriotism; and that gives incredible credence to faith, and champions the positive values of  
75 spirituality without diminishing or favoring any one particular dogma or religious creed, and is  
76 built upon the sacred foundations of loyalty, toleration, human liberty, and human progress; and

78 **WHEREAS**, the Order of DeMolay has spread to twenty-four countries around the world  
79 to date, all with various political, religious, and cultural foundations; and

80

81 **WHEREAS**, there are numerous DeMolay chapters in the state of Missouri, including  
82 clubs being developed on Missouri college campuses, with over one thousand active DeMolays  
83 and thousands more alumni who are actively involved in serving their communities; and

85 **WHEREAS**, Missouri has been a leader in DeMolay International since 1919 in the most  
86 worthy needed causes, including education, membership, programming, and youth leadership:

88 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of  
89 Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate  
90 concurring therein, hereby recognize Missouri DeMolay as an Institution of Higher Education  
91 and designate March eighteenth of each year as DeMolay Day and recommend that the citizens  
92 of the state engage in activities and conscious awareness to highlight the importance of youth  
93 leadership, rewarding higher education, and learning the cultural and historical significance of  
94 freedom of thought, freedom of religion, and freedom of speech in conjunction with the  
95 recognition of the consecrated leadership and wisdom of those who came before us who  
96 established, fought, and died for the perpetuation and preservation of such high universal ideals  
97 throughout the world; and

99 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
100 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the  
101 executive officer of the Missouri chapter of DeMolay International.
