AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Missouri whiskey.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 311.025, to read as follows:

3 **311.025. Notwithstanding any other law, intoxicating liquor shall not be advertised,**
4 **described, labeled, named, sold, or referred to for marketing and sales purposes as**
5 **"Missouri whiskey", "Missouri bourbon", or "Missouri bourbon whiskey", unless the**
6 **intoxicating liquor is:**

- 7 (1) **Manufactured in the state of Missouri;**
- 8 (2) **Made of a grain mixture that is at least fifty-one percent Missouri-grown corn;**
- 9 (3) **Aged in new, charred Missouri oak barrels in the state of Missouri;**
- 10 (4) **Made with unfiltered, untreated Missouri water;**
- 11 (5) **Distilled to no more than one hundred sixty proof or eighty percent alcohol by**
12 **volume; and**
- 13 (6) **Bottled at no less than eighty proof or forty percent alcohol by volume.**
