AN ACT

To amend chapter 226, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to transportation fees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 226, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 226.148, to read as follows:

226.148. 1. Each fee or tax contained in chapters 226, 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, and
2 306 and section 389.612 that is to be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the state
3 transportation department or any division thereof may be subject to an annual increase
4 or decrease based on the percent increase or decrease in inflation as determined by the
5 Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for the United States as reported by the
6 Bureau of Labor Statistics, or its successor index, when approved by the department by
7 rule promulgated under chapter 536. The department may elect to adjust any such fees
8 based on an increase or decrease in the index from such time the original fee or tax was
9 first imposed.

10 2. The director may promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for the
11 administration of this section, including approval of any adjustment of fees or taxes as
12 provided in subsection 1 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is
13 defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall
14 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter
15 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and
16 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review,
17 to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
