2 3	WHEREAS , the United States Congress has recently enacted an electronic logging device mandate for trucks and specified commercial vehicles and its enforcement as a final rule is likely to cost two billion dollars or more; and

8 9	WHEREAS , the electronic monitoring requirement is an invasion of privacy mandated by the federal government; and

11 12	WHEREAS , the final rule greatly increases the final cost of consumer goods to the American people; and

14 15	WHEREAS , the final rule will inhibit economic activity and reduce job growth as well as inhibit economically efficient transactions nationwide; and

17 18 19	WHEREAS , the final rule is an Obama Administration imposition of corporate welfare that has the pernicious effect of benefitting politically powerful large corporations at the expense of small business; and

21 22	WHEREAS , the Secretary of the Treasury has the authority to waive the final rule or exempt all Americans from its enforcement under 49 U.S.C. Section 3113(a)(10):

24 25 26 27	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, hereby urge the Secretary of the Treasury to immediately suspend the final rule for all persons and companies nationwide; and
