2	WHEREAS , the state of Missouri is home to two esteemed historically black institutions of higher education, Lincoln University and Harris-Stowe State University; and

4 5	WHEREAS, nearly three hundred thousand students are enrolled at historically black institutions of higher education across the nation; and

7 8	WHEREAS , historically black institutions of higher education are a vital part of not just our nation's higher education system, but of the American dream; and

10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, despite the fact that historically black institutions of higher education provide educational opportunities to serve some of our nation's most promising students, these institutions too often struggle financially due to having smaller endowments, less money from alumni giving, and lower levels of federal and state investment; and

15 16 17	WHEREAS , as a result of lower levels of investment in such institutions, the infrastructure of these institutions has not kept pace with their growing student bodies and the demands of training students for the twenty-first century; and

19 20	WHEREAS, changes are needed to ensure that these important institutions of higher education continue to thrive and are accessible and strong for years to come; and

22 23	WHEREAS , changes are needed to solve inequities in how historically black institutions of higher education have been treated financially in the state of Missouri:

25 26 27 28	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, hereby urge a commitment to ensuring that the historically black institutions of higher education in this state are comparable to and competitive with the Columbia campus of the University of Missouri in

- all facets of their operations and programs and that such institutions are funded at the same level
- 30 as the University of Missouri in Columbia, on a per-student basis; and
