AN ACT

To repeal section 99.848, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to emergency services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 99.848, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 99.848, to read as follows:

99.848. 1. Notwithstanding subsection 1 of section 99.847, any district or emergency
services board providing emergency or dispatch services pursuant to chapter 190 or 321 shall
be entitled to reimbursement from the special allocation fund in the amount of at least fifty
percent nor more than one hundred percent of the district's tax increment.

5 2. An ambulance district board, as described in chapter 190, a fire protection 6 district board, as described in chapter 321, or an emergency services board, as described 7 in chapter 190, shall set the reimbursement rate prior to the time the assessment is paid 8 into the special allocation fund. If the redevelopment plan, area, or project is amended by 9 ordinance or by other means, the board shall have the right to recalculate the base year 10 and the refund amount under this section.

This section shall not apply to tax increment financing projects or districts approved
 prior to August 28, 2004.
