This bill modifies the Fairness in Public Construction Act by permitting the state or any political subdivision to enter into a union-only project labor agreement for the procurement of construction services on a project-by-project basis if the project is funded 50% or less with state funds. The bill defines the term "project labor agreement" and sets forth certain criteria that must be considered before the state or a political subdivision may enter into such an agreement. The bill further requires the state or political subdivision to publish its findings and hold a public hearing on its intent to enter into the project labor agreement. The bill establishes remedies by which an interested party may appeal and seek a determination from the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission as to whether the state or political subdivision has complied with the provisions of the Act. projects funded by greater than 50% of state funds, the state is prohibited from discriminating against an entity for entering or refusing to enter into any agreement with one or more labor organizations.
