

HB 1299 -- ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO CONTROL FUND

SPONSOR: Conway (104)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Budget by a vote of 26 to 0.

This bill specifies that the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control Fund shall be a dedicated fund used solely by the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control within the Department of Public Safety for administration, implementation, and enforcement of the sections specified in the bill.

This bill is the same as HB 191 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill would allow the funds to grow in the Alcohol and Tobacco Control Fund to be used to provide regulation and enforcement efforts by the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Conway.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
