HB 1375 -- POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS AWARENESS DAY

SPONSOR: Ruth

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Consent" by the Consent and House Procedure Committee by a vote of 12 to 0.

This bill designates June 27 of each year as "Posttraumatic Stress Awareness Day" in Missouri and encourages citizens to observe the day through activities which will increase awareness of posttraumatic stress.

This bill is the same as HCS HB 915 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill would bring awareness to post traumatic stress, which can be caused by many traumatic events.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Ruth.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
