HB 1463 -- FAMILY LAW PROCEEDINGS

SPONSOR: Kelley (127)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Judiciary by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill allows a guardian for an incapacitated person to file any motion permissible under Chapter 452, RSMo, on behalf of the incapacitated person.

This bill is the same as HB 119 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that guardians can currently file petitions for dissolution of marriage for their wards, but they cannot file family access motions for them.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Kelley and Christopher Cross.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
