HB 1528 -- HIGHER EDUCATION CIVICS ACHIEVEMENT EXAMINATION

SPONSOR: Dohrman

This bill requires that any student attending a public or private institution of higher education score at least 70% of the Missouri Higher Education Civics Achievement Examination as a condition of graduation from the institution. The exam shall consist of between 50 and 100 questions and may be administered online. In addition, the exam shall be similar to the United States citizenship exam and include questions which cover the United States Constitution, the United States Bill of Rights, governmental institutions, historical manifestations of federalism, and history of constitutional interpretation and amendments.
